

Free Conservation Education Programming for Title 1 Schools Thanks to T-Mobile

(Sacramento, CA – March 11, 2021) -- Thanks to a generous donation from T-Mobile, the Sacramento Zoo is proud to offer free virtual content for Title 1 schools in the greater Sacramento region.



For a limited time (March through May 2021 only), children in grades K-6 will have the opportunity to learn about conservation and their role in preserving the planet with the help of a fun and educational program designed by Sac Zoo educators. Through animal videos, zookeeper talks, and fun “guest” appearances, students will learn about wildlife conservation and what they can do to help.



This 25-minute, pre-recorded program meets Next Generation Science Standards and is a great addition to any classroom curriculum, allowing educators to authentically incorporate the content into ELA and math lessons as well. This content, one program for grades K-3 and another for grades 4-6, also includes a Teacher’s Guide, with viewing suggestions and additional activities to further the learning opportunities within California Curriculum Content standards.
